Expect to Experience:

- Perform in the role of a Behavioral Health Therapist.
- Schedule a minimum of 15 client care hours per week to ensure availability after initial training.
- Experience a variety of therapy types, including but not limited to: Play Therapy, School-Based Therapy, Individual Therapy (all age groups). Couples Therapy, and Family Therapy.
- Attend Friday morning clinical workshops and weekly CEU sessions.
- Participate in a minimum of 1 hour of individual supervision with an active Behavioral Health Therapist.
- Participate in a minimum of 1 hour of group supervision each week.
- Plan and participate in a minimum of two community outreach events.
- Collaborate with over 40 active clinicians with diverse licensures and therapy specializations.
